Hi Everyone,

Thank you to everyone for your kind donations for Children in Need last Friday. We raised a whopping £843! Just amazing!

I can't believe we are in the final full week of November, our Christmas trees at school are being delivered next week and the Christmas 'feels' are slowly creeping up around us here at school. Keep watching for the sparkle of Christmas to appear in the coming days!

As I wrote last week, just a further reminder that we are increasing the daily charges of breakfast club and after school care club from January 1st 2023. The main reason we provide these services is to provide our working families with the facility of affordable child care both before and after school. Within the Orion learning partnership made up of; Saltaire Primary School, Eldwick Primary School and Hoyle Court Primary School, we work with, their prices are very similar to ours with a very similar offer. The main source of expense to operate these services is staffing and the ever rising energy costs. We have to provide a fully staffed ratio from the beginning of each session to the end of each session and therefore have to pay for these costs in order to be appropriately staffed for whenever the children arrive or leave due to flexible drop in and out nature of breakfast club. I do understand how financially stretched everyone is in the current climate, our school budget is extremely tight too and we are trying our best to limit passing on costs to our families as much as we can but the school budget just cannot absorb any further increments in costs. As always, please do contact me should you need support with your individual circumstances and I will do all I can to support you and your family.
