Hi Everyone,

As I wrote last week, our spring term parent's evenings will be held on **Tuesday 15th and Wednesday 16th of February at 3.30pm until 6.30pm**. Children's Mental Health Week (CMHW) takes place from 7-13th of February. The theme this year is 'Growing Together'. Throughout the week the whole school will be immersing themselves into various wellbeing activities which class teachers will share on Dojo. **On Friday 11th of February,** we will celebrate 'Dress to Express day'. The vending machine will be filled with books and children will be given tokens which they can use to get books. This aligns brilliantly with school's current push on reading, and hopefully we can raise enough money to buy the vending machine and some of the reading books needed for the machine.



All the children will be handed out a full Smarties tube on Friday 11th February (alternative sweets will be provided for those unable to eat Smarties) and we would like the tubes to be handed back into school on Friday 18th February with as many coins as possible.

We will then announce how much we have raised on World Book Day, 6th March and hopefully it will be enough to buy the vending machine!
