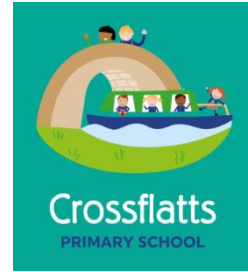

Hi Everyone,

The PTA will also be running a Christmas Shop in school on Thursday 9th December where the children can buy presents for family and friends.
