Ensuring our school's cybersecurity, and online child protection protocols is vital for keeping children and young people, out of harm's way. With computing now an integral part of what every school does, from the administrative level to computing lessons it is imperative that everyone, in our

school is protected. At Crossflatts Primary school we use a robust filtering and monitoring system so that every key stroke on any device used in our school is monitored. Should any inappropriate words or sentences be typed into a search engine, document or email etc. I receive an alert and screen shot of the

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words, which have been typed, as a possible cause of concern. This ensures we can closely monitor all device usage in our school and be vigilant at all times of anything inappropriate or content which could be harmful to children. We have an extremely effective filtering system which blocks internet access to harmful sites and inappropriate content which doesn't unreasonably impact teaching and learning or school administration. Of course as we also ensure as part of our curriculum that we teach our children how to assess and manage risk themselves when they are online.
