Year 6 Residential Visit to Lockerbie Wednesday 28th June – Friday 30th June 2023



We are very excited to begin the planning of our Year 6 residential visit to **Lockerbie Manor in Scotland**! We are really looking forward to this action packed three days of adventurous activities, which will be a wonderful end to the Crossflatts journey.

Lockerbie Manor is based in Dumfries and Galloway and is set amidst 78 acres of woodland and fields. We have been taking children on this visit for several years now and it is a fantastic trip. The children will stay in a wooden pod village with all of the required amenities.



Whilst at Lockerbie, the children will participate in a series of exciting activities such as archery, canoeing, kayaking, rock climbing, abseiling, obstacle course, mountain biking and fencing. The staff at the centre offer expert tuition in all of these activities and will be supported by the Crossflatts' staff to ensure that the children have a fun filled three days.

The visit will take place from **Wednesday 28th June to Friday 30th June 2023**. We will travel to and from the venue by coach, leaving on Wednesday morning and returning on Friday tea time.

The total cost of the visit will be **approximately £280** per child (subject to change depending on final numbers) and will cover transport, accommodation, food and activities.



If you would like your child to take part in the visit, please can you pay the £50.00 deposit online via ParentPay by **Friday 21st October**. If you know that your child is definitely unable to attend the visit, please contact us so that we can remove the deposit amount from ParentPay for you. After the initial deposit, you will be able to pay the rest of the balance in instalments. The balance is due by 1st March 2023.

As this is the final residential at primary school, we would love as many children as possible to take part so please contact us at school if you have any concerns or questions so that we can help to make arrangements for the visit.

We will be holding a meeting closer to the time of the visit to go through the itinerary, the kit list and to make sure that you have all of the information that you need.

We are very excited about this visit and we know that it is going to be a wonderful send off for the Year 6s.
